

Terms & Conditions For Road Sweeper Hire

Definitions

- We/our/us – Citysweep Ltd
- Hirer – Person, Firm or Company or other Party taking the Sweeper on Hire
- On Site – Construction Site or other facility other than the Public Highway where sweeping operations are to take place.

General

- Where the agreed hire is to be charged at an hourly rate, chargeable hours will commence when the sweeper leaves our Mayfield Depot and will conclude upon its return.
- For contracts not charged at an hourly rate the agreed scope of work and charging arrangements will be confirmed by quotation at the outset of the contract.
- If no representative of the hirer is available on site to sign any ticket or electronic device confirming receipt of goods or service, the hirer will be invoiced without signature. We will not accept invoice queries for lack of signature
- Off site tipping charges will be charged unless the hirer specifies that on site tipping facilities are available
- Payment terms are strictly 30 days from date of invoice. We reserve the right to apply late payment interest if the invoice is not settled in that time.
- If tipping is required on site, it is the hirers responsibility to provide sufficient, suitable and adequate area where the load can be discharged safely.
- The hirer is responsible for and will indemnify us against all claims and costs arising from any environmental pollution/contamination resulting or arising from on site tipping
- The hirer is responsible for and will indemnify us against all claims arising from damage caused to roads, kerbs, manhole covers etc or services and utilities caused by the travelling, placement or operating of the sweeper
- The hirer is responsible and will reimburse us for the costs arising from any punctures occasioned while on site howsoever caused.
- The hirer is responsible for ensuring ground conditions are suitable and capable of withstanding ground pressure exerted by the sweeper.
