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## Project Challenges & Solutions

The NWH Group collaborated closely with AKP Scotland Ltd to identify and optimise opportunities for cost savings, increased operational efficiency and sustainability, allowing the project stay under budget while maintaining high on-site standards.

- **Daily Exchanges:** The NWH Group implemented a tailored schedule for daily collections and exchanges of skips and hooks, ensuring that the site remained free from excess waste.
- **Wait & Load Service:** Offered rapid and responsive waste removal, providing the flexibility to adapt to site demands during peak construction periods.
- **Recycling Success:** An impressive 98.87% of the total waste was recycled and diverted from landfills, with the remaining 1.13% converted into energy.
- **Optimised Skip Usage:** By evaluating the volume and types of waste produced, the NWH Group recommended specific skip sizes to minimise exchanges and reduce costs.
- **Real-time Scheduling:** The NWH Group's dynamic scheduling system allowed for immediate adjustments in response to project needs, minimising downtime and maximising efficiency.
- **Consolidated Waste Streams:** On-site segregation of recyclable materials enabled AKP to decrease landfill costs and enhance recycling efforts, contributing to further savings.
- **Waste Reduction Strategy:** The NWH Group worked with AKP to identify waste minimisation strategies, encouraging the reuse of materials when feasible, thereby cutting disposal costs and reducing environmental impact.
